4. It may be noted that the first installment of the sanctioned amount will be released only after receipt of the documents/ information mentioned in **Para no. 2**. If no response is received within 10 days from the date of issue of this letter, the approval will be deemed to have been cancelled.

Report (Session-wise summary)

Inauguration:

A two day NCW sponsored national seminar was organized in our college on 3rd and 4th January 2020. As per the schedule the seminar was inaugurated at the hands of Hon. Nilima Theurkar, Nayab Tahsildar Ashti at 10 am on 3rd January 2020. The President of Ashti Taluka Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Hon. Kishor Hambarde was chairperson of the inaugural function. Mrs. Sharda Dalvi guided the audience about the policies of government and related her own story. Hon. Kishor Hambarde in his complimentary close assured the lady parents and girl students the safety in college and promotion of women empowerment policies in college. Prin. Dr. S. R. Nimbore in his preface talked about the objectives and schedule of the two day national seminar. Prof. Mrs. Shubhangi Khude compered the sessions. Mrs. Saraswati Jadhav expresses vote of thanks.

Hence the inaugural function.

Day I – Session I – (11.00 am to 12.00 noon)

Hon. Kumar Sudhanshu Ray, the manager State Bank of India, Ashti was the resource person for technical session I. Vice Principal Dr. Suhas Gopane was the chairperson of this session. Mr. Ray explained the banking work and talked about the facilities banks provide for smooth sailing of transactions, especially about the precautions to be taken in online transactions. Some delegates raised questions to which Mr. Ray gave satisfactory answers. Some women entrepreneurs and girl students asked questions to which Mr. Ray responded and said about the need of a special workshop.

Day I – Session II (12.00 noon to 01.00 pm)

Hon. Deepak Mangwani, the manager, State Bank of India, station road, Ashti was the resource person for session II. Dr. B. N. Mutkule, Head, Department of Commerce was the chairperson. Mr. Mangwani explained the new apps the banks have developed and how the use of these apps could minimize the rush and crowd in bank. The delegates shared their experiences in bank and they also gave some suggestions. Mr. Mangwani also shared his experiences of customers and appealed all to promote online transactions.

Day I – Session III (01.00 pm to 02.00 pm)

Hon. Sushila Morale Ex. Head, Dept. of Political science, Bankatswami college Beed was the resource person for session III. Dr. Mangal Tekade from A. D. College, Kada was the chairperson.

Mrs. Sushila Morale spoke about women empowerment in general and issues of working women in particular. She shared some of her experiences. Mrs. Morale commented on political misconducts and dual nature of leaders in women empowerment policies. She advised women and girl students to be more aggressive as per the need of the situation.

Day I – Session IV (03.00 pm to 04.00 pm)

Hon. Mrs. Manisha Chavare, the President of Zunjar Nari Manch, Ashti was the resource person and prof. Shubhangi Khude was the chairperson of the session. Mrs. Manisha Chavare talked about her experiences of gatherings and celebrations of women in Ashti on various occasions. She encouraged women for entrepreneurship and insisted that she started with a small beauty parlor to reach the present destination. She communicated her readiness and willingness to support the needy women who want to make career in beauty industries

Day II – Session V

Hon. Dr. Deepa Sawale, Principal, SMGRG Shinde Mahavidyalaya, Bhoom was the resource person of this session. Hon. Prin. Dr. S. R. Nimbore was the chairperson. Mrs. Sawale talked on women empowerment: A need of the day. Her interactive session was move effective. She spoke about the women empowerment policies of government. She also spoke about the gender sensitization issue especially in higher education. She shared her experience with the girl students and lady parents who were hesitating initially but later became bit bold after interaction with her.

Day II – Session VI

Hon. Dr. Suparna Deshmukh, Head, Dept. of Chemistry, Gandhi College, Kada was the resource person. Mrs. Manisha Devgunne was the chairperson. Mrs. Deshmukh spoke about health of women in family and in society. She demonstrated yoga and meditation. She also stated how yoga can make you fit and that fitness is very important. With reference of Ravi Shankar and Art of living she claimed that meditation is more powerful than medication.

Day II – Session VII

Hon. Mrs. Renuka Bhalerao was the resource person of this session. She is a very famous entrepreneur in Aurangabad. She shared her experiences in running Abacus centre in Aurangabad. She answered the question raised by the delegates. Mrs. Saraswati Jadhav was the chairperson of the session. Mrs. Bhalerao stated that women are prone to family while men are prone to society. She also said that women must come out of four walls and set out for business so that they could be self-sufficient.

Day II – Session VII

Hon. Dr. Sunita Bombe, Department of Marathi, Gandhi college, Kada was the resource person of this session. Mrs. Shobha Narote was the chairperson. Mrs. Bombe spoke about working

women issues and the solutions. She insisted the need of self-sufficient women for better society. She appealed all audience in general and girls in particular to promote gender equality.

Day II – Valedictory

Hon. Dr. Mahananda Dalvi, Head, Dept. of English and Senate member in Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad was the resource person and guest of valedictory function. Hon. Mr. Atulkumar Meher the secretary, Ashti Taluka Shikshan Prasarak Mandal was the chairperson. Mrs. Dalvi spoke about the group of girl students activated in her college. She shared her own experiences of activities of the group.

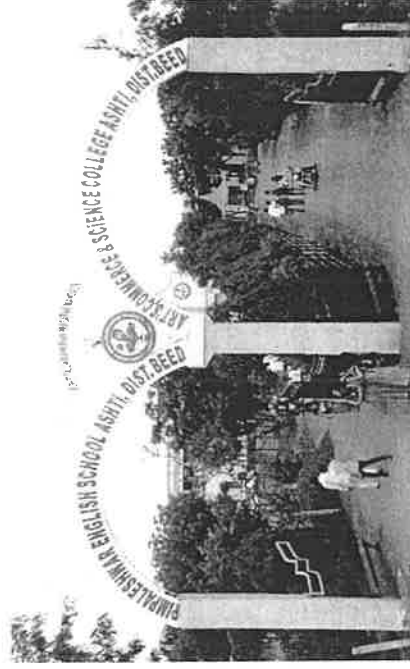
