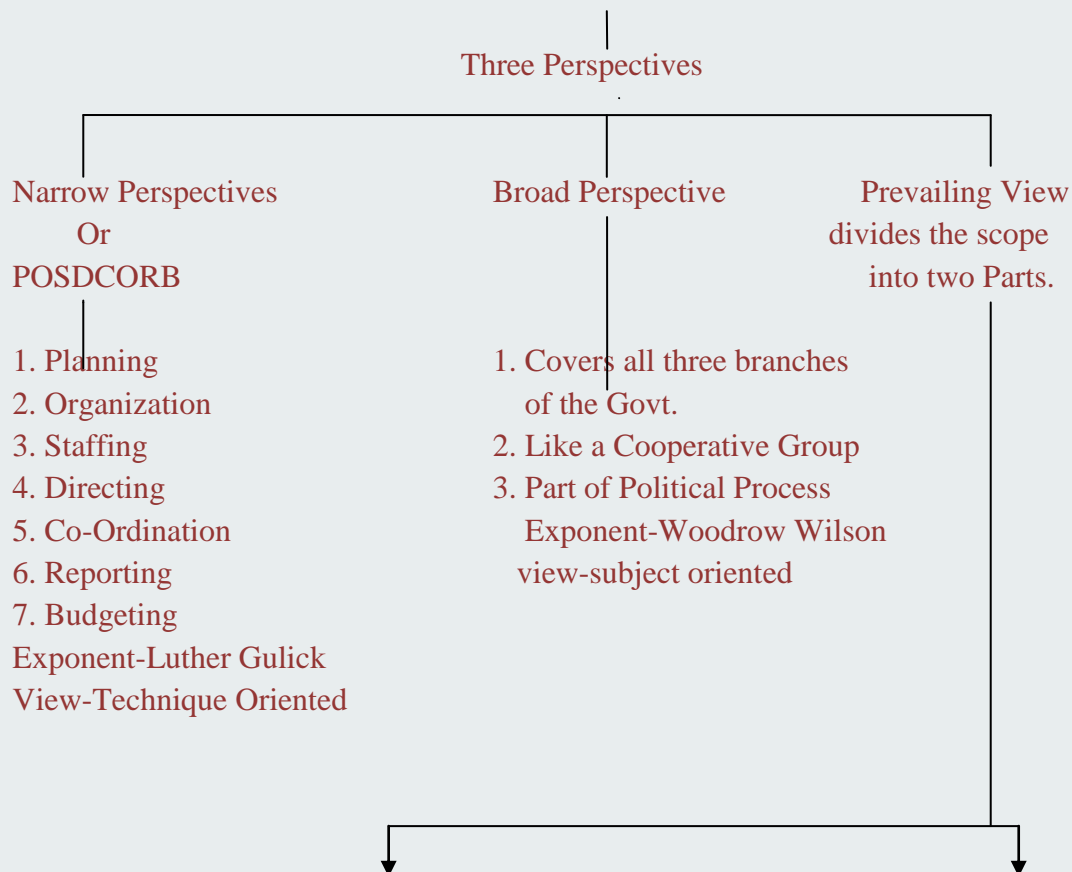
A. IMPORTANCE OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION:
