2. INTRODUCTION OF DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE:

The Department of commerce was established in the year 1972. Mr. S.G. Magare was the first Head of the Department. In 1973 Mr. L. S. Shinde was appointed as a lecturer in the year 1974 and Mr. D. Y. Chalak was appointed as a lecturer. In the year 1985, Mr.R. B. Hambarde was appointed as a lecturer.

At present Prof S.G.Magare, Prof. V.L Shinde, Prof. D.Y. Chalak and Prof. R. B. Hambarde got retired. Dr. B. N. Mutkule is working as a Head of the department. Prof. Shirsath M. K and Dr. S. G. Gopane are appointed as assistant professors in the department in the year 2015 and 2016 respectively. In 2002 the new subject I.T.A.B. started in the Commerce department. For implementation of its practical, Computer lab is mandatory. As far as need is concerned, the computer lab is installed from June 2002. Prof A.B. Sanap was the first in charge of our Computer lab. There are 20 new Computers in the lab.

Thereafter in the year 2012-2013 new Certificate Courses like E-Commerce and E-Banking have started with the help of University Grants Commission. In 2018 one Diploma Course “Accounting and Taxation” run under National Skill Qualification Framework. The project work and field visits are essential to develop practical experience of the students. The students of our department visited S.B.I. Bank, S.B.H Bank, Cotton mill, Dairy plant, Forge factory, Sugar factory etc. Dr. B. N. Mutkule was an in-charge of study tour; under his guidance students were motivated for practical experience which is helpful to them for getting jobs in various companies and factories.

In the same way Commerce department has organized a UGC Sponsored National Conference on the subject “Entrepreneurship Development” on dated 27 and 28 December 2013. The vice-chancellor Dr. Vijay Pandharipande inaugurated the Conference. Dr. Walmik Sarode Head of department of Commerce Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, and Dean Dr. K. B. Laghane were the Chief guests of Valedictory function. In the conference 53 Researcher and students took part and read their research papers. We also organized Interdisciplinary

National Conference on “Recent Trends in Social Sciences and Commerce” on dated 27th February 2018. In this conference 81 researchers participated and presented his papers. This conference was fruitful for students and teachers. The department arranges the guest lectures on various subjects by inviting the eminent persons from various sectors.

The department arranges various activities which are helpful to increase the strength in the department. At present 68 computers are available in the computer lab, all computers are connected with internet facilities Now, all Faculty members of Commerce department are highly qualified. They have very good interaction with students. They usually participate in college and University assignment work time to time.
