#### General Rules for Admission

- 1. Admission to XI Class will be given to the students who have passed the S.S.C. Examination from any Divisional Board of Maharashtra state Board of Secondary Education.
- 2. Students from the States other than Maharashtra seeking admission to XI should apply for the eligibility Certificate to the H.S.C. Board Aurangabad. Their admission will be finalized only after the sanction of Eligibility by the Board.
- 3. Admission to B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., and B.C.A. first year shall be given to the students who have passed the H.S.C. Exam, from any division of the Maharashtra State Board or Secondary and Higher Secondary Education. Admissions are also open for students who belong to other states or countries.
- 4. The students who have passed D.T.Ed. Exam (Diploma in Education) and Diploma in Polytechnic are also eligible for admission to B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. and B.C.A. First year.
- 5. The students must retain all the receipts of fees or dues obtained by them. The refund of the fees deposits and other amounts shall not be paid unless the receipts are produced.
- 6. The prescribed fees and other charges must be paid at the time of admission.
- 7. The students should apply for admission before the prescribed date.
- 8. All necessary documents, certificates and undertakings should be submitted in original at the time of admission.
- 9. The principal has the discretionary powers to make any change in the rules of admissions within the framework of norms laid down by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
- 10. Initially all admissions will be given on the provisional basis. Admission is liable to be cancelled if any irregularity or discrepancy in documents is detected during the year.
- 11. Students will have to complete the procedure of admission every year for a new class. The admission will be for one academic year only.
- 12. The students from the state of Maharashtra seeking admissions to B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. and B.C.A. first year should apply for the eligibility certificate to Dr. B.A.M.U. Aurangabad. Their admissions shall be finalized only after the issue of the eligibility certificate from the University.
- 13. The subject selection and combination, offered once will remain final.

### Infrastructure and student support services

#### 1. Administrative block.

The office is fully computerized. There are separate sections, windows for various services, Seeking admission, filling forms of scholarship, EBC, free ship, getting leaving certificate, bonafide, identity card, convocation forms, paying fees by cash, through swipe machine photocopying, attestation etc. services are made student friendly.

#### 2. Grand library (KRC)

Our library known as Knowledge Resource Center is the most pioneer in the district, w i t h 30,000 books, 1200 reference books, 20 National and international journals,, encyclopedia, dictionaries, magazines and newspapers. Its Fully computerized with OPAC and INFLIBNET facilities. Every year there is a purchase according to the demands of staff and students.

#### 3. Gymkhana

We provide all sports facilities of indoor and outdoor games with special attention to the students tournaments. All modern equipment are made available in Gym and special coaching is provided. Nutrient diet is supplied to the deserving sports students. Indoor games like chess and carom are played by students in free time. Yoga camp is organized every year on 21st June

#### 4. Late B.D. Hambarde Stadium

The stadium spreads over 7 acres area with 400 Mtrs. Running track and various sports grounds as cricket, Kho-Kho, volleyball, football, Kabaddi, tennis and badminton. Students practise on ground every day. A special coaching camp is organized in the eve of some ICT or IUT tournamens.

#### 5. Women's Hostel

A specious women's hostel is available with boarding facility for the girl students in the outskirts of Ashti willing to stay in hostel. Intake capacity of the hostel is 100. Along with safety and security hostel provides an opportunity of higher education to the girls in surrounding villages.

#### 6. Ladies common room with toilet facility

For the girl students and ladies staff, a ladies common room is made available with toilet facility. Also a sanitary napkin vending machine is in operation. Ladies from the staff and girl students can rest here in recesses.

#### 7. Laboratories

All science laboratories are well equipped and updated. Every year there is new purchase. Dead stock and all records are maintained. Fire extinguisher is fixed one in each laboratory. Students use masks and aprons wherever necessary.

#### 8. Computer lab

We have a well-furnished computer lab with 50 computers in LAN, students of B.C.A. make optimum use of the lab but every common student too goes to lab and is familiar with it.

#### 9. Auditorium

we have spacious auditorium cum theater with 1000 seats, sound system, modern dias and wall mounted projector. It is used for meetings, training, seminars, conferences, workshops, cultural programmes, parents meetings and various competitions.

#### 10. Language Laboratory

 $Language \ lab \ with 30+1\ computers \ is \ in operation for learning languages. \ Though \ it \ is \ used mainly for English language, there are software programmes for Hindi and Marathi languages. \ With head phone and mike, students can learn speaking in self learning mode. Software programme of Clarity English language is installed in all 30 computers. With server computer teacher controls all computers and students.$ 

#### 11. Network Resources Centre (NRC)

Adjacent to KRC, there is NRC, Network Resources Centre which gives an access to internet. Staff and students visit NRC frequently. Though entire campus is WiFi, NRC has its own significance. It has

printer and photocopy machine too.

#### 12. Virtual Classroom

We have a virtual classroom for online lectures and classes. Almost every teacher makes ample use of ICT in teaching. Smart boards and projectors are available in a good number. All sort of soft material is used in teaching, learning and research. Smart board proves helpful especially in diagrams, figures and graphs.

#### 13. National Service Scheme (NSS)

NSS is executed in senior and junior college with 2 units of 250 students, each. Special camps are organized in rural area where students are taught the value of physical work, community service and personality development. In NSS, extension services as blood donation, AIDS awareness, cleanliness drive, water conservation and tree plantation are undertaken.

#### 14. Lifelong Learning and extension

The department provides an opportunity to the students to undergo career guidance programmes. The unit consists of 50 students and organizes guidance camps for students. Extension activities and services are undertaken by the department.

#### 15. Blood Donation Camp

Every year a blood donation camp is organized in college in 11th November, birthday of president Er. Kishor Hambarde. Around 100 donors donate blood in this camp. Ahmednagar Blood bank collects blood and issues certificates to donors. Health camp and HB detection camp for girls is organized on the same day.

#### 16. Earn and Learn Scheme

Late Vasantrao Kale Swabhiman Shikshan Yojana (Earn and Learn Scheme) is in operation for needy and deserving students. The scheme gives an opportunity to earn while they learn. In this scheme, student work in library, campus and office to make money.

#### 17. Yuvaspandan

The magazine with the writings of students is published annually to promote students creative writing. Students write articles, poems and write ups in Marathi, Hindi and English. Editorial board scrutinizes the material and is published in Yuvaspandan magazine. Students seek guidance from concerned teachers and reflect their hidden talent.

#### 18. Student Council

Every year students' council is formed with representatives of all classes. Throughout the year, council organizes various programmes in college like flag hoisting, birth and dearth anniversaries of great leaders, university foundation day and all. General secretary elected from among the council, communicates with the authority regarding students common problems.

#### 19. Culture Committee

Cultural committee promotes students to participate in extracurricular activities. Students are sent to other colleges to participate in debate, poetry recitation and elocution competitions. Committee offers special guidance for youth festival in the university. Every year students register in youth festival for various events.

#### 20. Annual College Gathering

Every year, gathering provides an opportunity to the students willing to perform on stage. Gathering is an attraction not for the students only but for the parents, villagers, spectators and ex-students as well. Thousands of people arrive in campus to witness the artists, dancers singers and actors in students.

#### 21. State level elocution Competition

Every year on 18th August, the death anniversary of Late B.D. Hambarde, a state level elocution competition is organized. Topics, generally on current affairs are fixed. Invitations are forwarded to almost all colleges in Maharashtra. Cash prizes & Trophies are given to the winners while certificates a  $\, {\rm r} \, {\rm e} \,$ 

issued to all participants.

### 22. State level Poetry Recitation Competition

Every year on 22nd November, the death anniversary of Late Mansukhlal Meher, a state level comic marathi poetry recitation competition is organized. Participants from various colleges present comic poems and get recognition. Cash prizes, Trophies and certificates are issued. Our students too get inspiration for the same

#### 23. Alumni Association

Alumni association is formed in college. It is to be registered to Charity Commissioner Beed. Members of association hold meeting in college to discuss about welfare programmes for students. Suggestions and recommendations of Alumni association are noted down by CDC and the management.

#### 24. Research Committee

Research Committee in college encourages students and staff to send research papers to journals and seminars. Minor research project proposals are also forwarded to university. Individual record is maintained by committee.

#### 25. Career Guidance Cell

The cell is active in college which guides students especially preparing for civil service examinations. Guidance about examinations, qualifying criteria and coaching classes help students to pass competitive exams.

#### 26. Placement Cell

The cell organizes campus interviews of various companies and industries. Students are given direct calls in the campus itself.

#### 27. RTI

Right To Information act is observed in college. Special officers are appointed for the same. Though few cases are reported, officers are keen to work for that by maintaining all the records in soft copies as well as hard copies.

#### 28. Anti Ragging/Discipline

As Discipline committee in college is active, anti ragging committee has no much work. If senior students are found torturing juniors, they are counseled first and punished otherwise on the spot. Discipline committee checks that no outsider has entered in campus.

#### 29. Anti Sexual Harassment

Sexual Harassment at work place becomes a serious issue now. Anti Sexual harassment committee receives complains and report accordingly. Cases are comparatively rare

#### 30. Pollution free Saturday

To keep the environment of the campus pollution free, fourth Saturday of every month is observed as pollution free Saturday. Automobiles are not brought in the campus and we experience c a  $1\ m$ , quite, sound free and pollution free day in a month.

#### 31. Farm Pond

Farm Pond with 25 Lakh Ltr. capacity constructed in the campus meets the need of water in summer. Ground water and roof water harvesting is working in campus. Water collected is directed and store in the farm pond.
